## A reminder around tests

**Question:** In the absence of a PCR, test but where there are symptoms and a positive LF test, should a bubble be closed?

### What should I do if I test positive with an LFD test?

If your result is positive, you **and your contacts** should start isolation immediately. You will be encouraged to book a confirmatory PCR test within 2 days. (This is not mandatory, but if you don't your isolation period will be 10 days from the date of the LFD test) Confirmatory PCR tests are booked via gov.uk or by calling 119. It is important to be tested within 2 days of a positive LFD Test.

### Information below is assimilated from current guidance:

If you receive a positive LFD result you must book a PCR immediately and self-isolate, *along with your close contacts*. If you then receive a negative result from the PCR, and the PCR test was taken within 2 days of the LFD, then you and your contacts will be informed they can cease self-isolating.

If an individual has a positive LFD at home and decides not to take a PCR test they (*and their contacts*) should continue to isolate for the full 10 days.

If an individual has a positive LFD at home and takes a PCR test and its negative, they can come out of isolation, along with their contacts.

The above especially applies where there are symptoms as the risk of infection is high. Anyone with symptoms should always take a PCR test.


