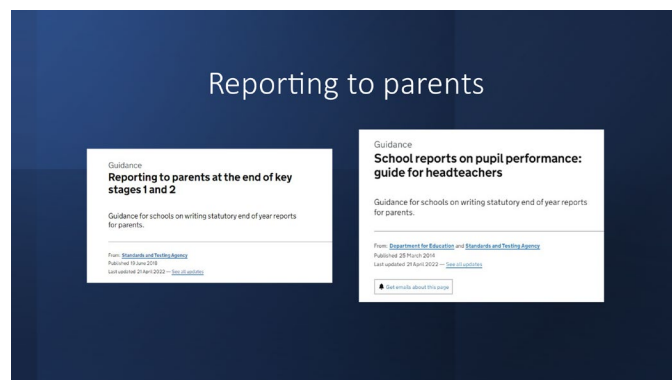
Health advice on managing outbreaks
