## VERY HIGH ALERT LEVEL

for Derby



### SOCIALISING

No meeting with other households indoors, except support bubbles. Rule of 6 applies in outdoor public spaces.



### BARNS, PUBS AND RESTAURANTS

Hospitality is closed with the exception of takeaway and delivery sales.



### RETAIL

All retail to open, including indoor and outdoor markets and car boot sales.



### WORK AND BUSINESS

Everyone who can work from home should.



### EDUCATION

Early years, schools, colleges and universities open. Childcare bubbles permitted.



### INDOOR SPORT

Leisure and sports facilities open – no group activities.



### ACCOMMODATION

Hotels, B&Bs etc closed with limited exceptions.



### PERSONAL CARE

Such as beauty salons, barbers, nail salons - open.



### OVERNIGHT STAYS

Avoid overnight stays except with household or support bubble.



### WEDDINGS AND FUNERALS

Up to 15 guests for weddings, civil partnerships and wakes. 30 for funerals. Wedding receptions are not permitted.



### ENTERTAINMENT

Indoor venues closed.



### PLACES OF WORSHIP

Open, but cannot interact with anyone outside of household or support bubble.



### TRAVEL

Avoid travel outside Derby unless essential and reduce journeys. Avoid car sharing.



### EXERCISE

Classes and organised sport can take place outside. Elite sports and under 18's and disabled activities can continue.



### RESIDENTIAL CARE

COVID-secure arrangements only – outdoor and airtight visits unless rapid testing is rolled out.



### LARGE EVENTS

Events should not take place. Drive-in events permitted.
