We know you are an inventive set of leaders but safety comes first as you know.

We are continuing to plan for the Holiday Activity and Food (HAF) Programme but we will also need to give the bubbles some thought. We will be providing more detail on this shortly.

We have been asked to clarify that there will be no food vouchers this coming holiday – the HAF Programme includes food but only for those children who turn up.
