

SEND: The Derby Way - Pre-assessment checklist

Deciding when to make a request for assessment can be difficult. Our SENCO network has produced a checklist to help you to decide if it's the right time to request an assessment:

| Have I consulted with parents and the pupil when considering an application? | |

| I can show how the parents have been involved in developing the graduated response plan and in reviewing its success? | |
| Can I demonstrate that I have applied the Graduated Response? | |
| Can I demonstrate that the notional funding is insufficient to meet his/her needs? | |
| Can I provide evidence of how the notional funding has been spent and the impact this has had on x? | |
| Have I got sufficient evidence of 2 cycles of plan, do and review through an IEP/MEP? | |
| If I am applying for a child under exceptional circumstances, can I justify my application? | |
| Have I used my EP to produce a report to support my application? | |
| Can I clearly articulate the desired outcomes in each of the primary areas for the pupil? | |
| Is the information I have provided the most up to date and therefore presents the most realistic picture of the child I am making the application for? | |
| Should my application go to appeal, do I have the support and additional evidence to justify why I believe the child needs a plan? | |
| Have I got all the information required on the application which is required on the form? | |
| You might want to get another member of staff who knows the child well or a professional you work closely with to read through my application. | |
| Have I gone through the threshold documents for the pupil with my EP? Especially when they come out with a high score on their Primary Area of Need. | |
