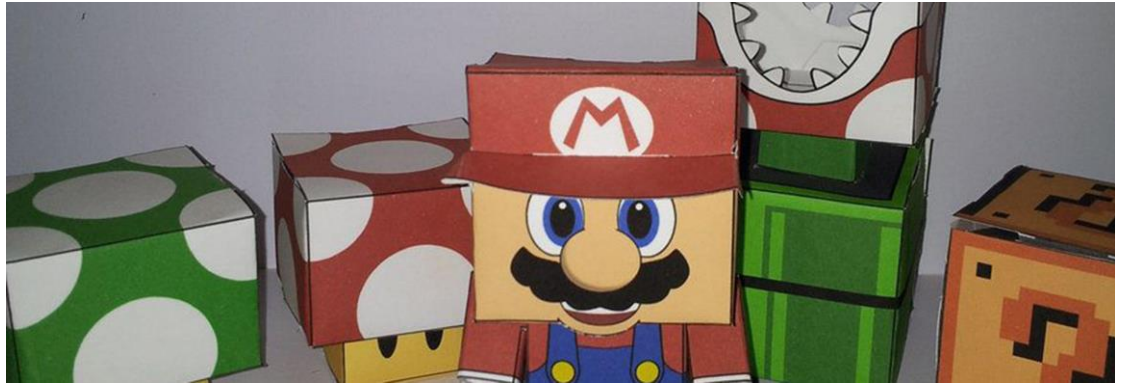

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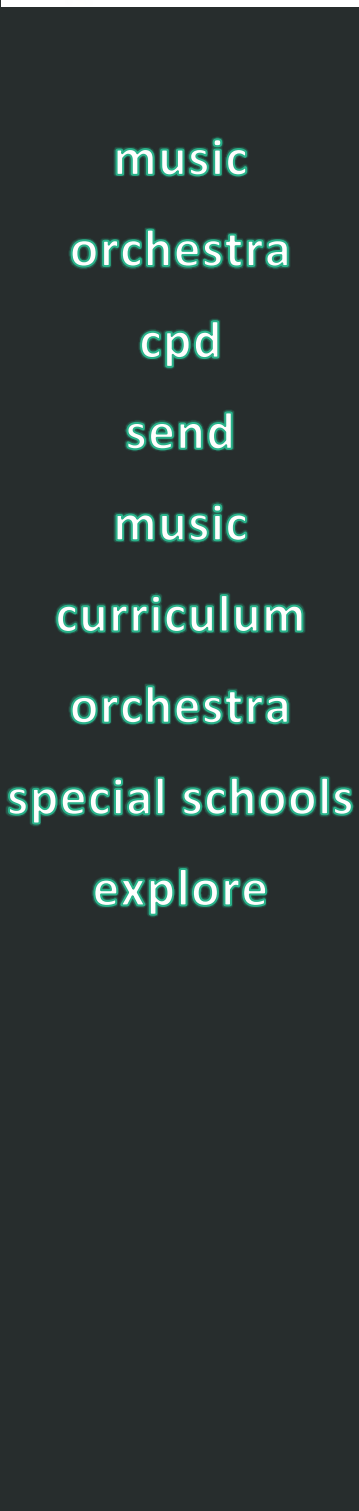

Derby & Derbyshire Music Partnership

Wider opportunities for the next academic year are now being finalised for hundreds of schools across Derby City and Derbyshire, with thousands of pupils learning in the whole class setting strings, woodwind, brass, world percussion and ukulele.

The new National Plan for Music Education (version2) comes into effect in September 2023. Derby & Derbyshire Music Partnership have offered an online twilight for schools to support them with the expected Schools Music Development Plans, and we are repeating this offer on 23.5.23 www.derbyshiremusichub.org.uk/development-plan for all schools to book the session which will run from 3.45-4.30pm

The national structure of music hubs has been announced by DfE (Department for Education) and Arts Council and DDMP (Derby & Derbyshire Music Partnership) geographical working areas remain the same: Derby & Derbyshire. Many neighbouring hubs are being restructured to join with other local authority areas. All Music Education Hub lead organisations must rebid to lead their hubs for September 2024.
