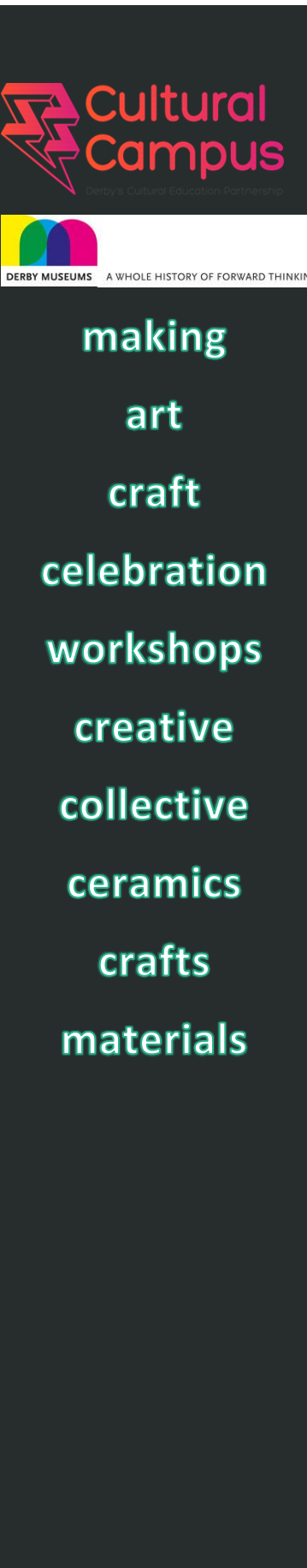

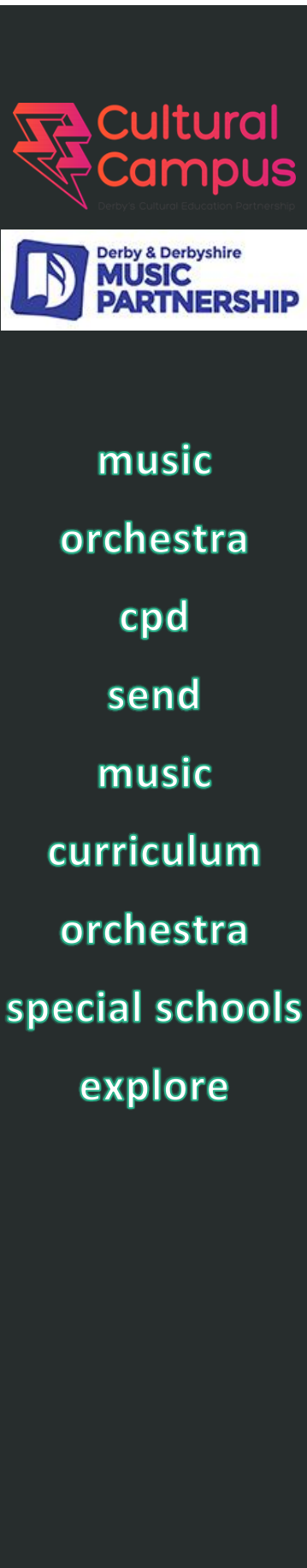
Derby Museums

Derby & Derbyshire Music Partnership

The revised [National Plan for Music Education](#) states that schools should have a [School Music Development Plan \(SMDP\)](#) in place. The National Plan sets out the government's vision for music education and how this can be achieved through partnerships with schools, music hubs, the music and creative sector, and others: *"to enable all children and young people to learn to sing, play an instrument and create music together, and have the opportunity to progress their musical interests, including professionally"*. The [Derby & Derbyshire Music Partnership](#) is required by Arts Council England and the DfE to engage with all schools and to hold annual [School Music Education Plan \(SMEP\)](#) conversations with school.
